SOUPER BOWL of CARING

What is "The Souper Bowl of Caring"? The Souper Bowl of caring is the result of thousands of young people joining together to fight hunger and poverty in their local communities. This unique, youth-led movement of caring is transforming the nation's biggest weekend of football into its largest weekend of giving.

We are on a mission to fight hunger and poverty.

YOU can help.

Our youth will hold soup pots at church doors on Souper Bowl Sunday. They will join young people in churches all across the country to collect money for those who are hungry and hurting. In 2006, 11,000 groups in all 50 states and outside the United States participated in the Souper Bowl of Caring generating over \$5 million. All of the money collected is donated to a charity selected by the participant. None of the money is sent to Souper Bowl headquarters. Organizers only ask that each participant report their collection so national totals can be determined and announced. Since the Souper Bowl of Caring became a national grassroots event in 1993, more than \$33 million has gone to help those in need. Please support the youth of our church in this effort to "love our neighbors" by dropping your dollar in the soup pot on Souper Bowl Sunday.
