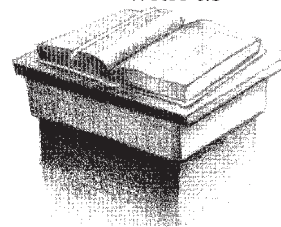

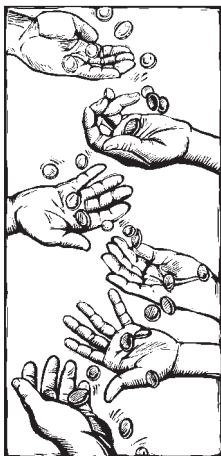

## Keeping Children Safe Sessions

### *What Are They? Why Should I Attend?*

All volunteers who have contact with children, youth, or vulnerable adults are **required** to attend a 3-hour session on *Keeping Children, Youth and Vulnerable Adults Safe* once every three (3) years. This is mandated by the Diocese of Fort Worth and is designed to help insure the safety of children and young people. The sessions are held at various parishes throughout the diocese and are offered in both English and Spanish. In order for a group to reserve a room at MBS for activities involving children, all adults involved must complete the *Keeping Children, Youth, and Vulnerable Adults Safe* program.
