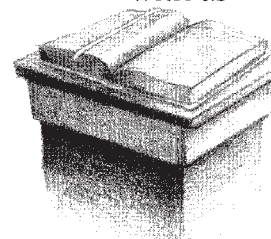

The Community Service Committee is having its annual drive for socks and underwear. Please note that teachers have expressed a need for plain, white t-shirts, also.

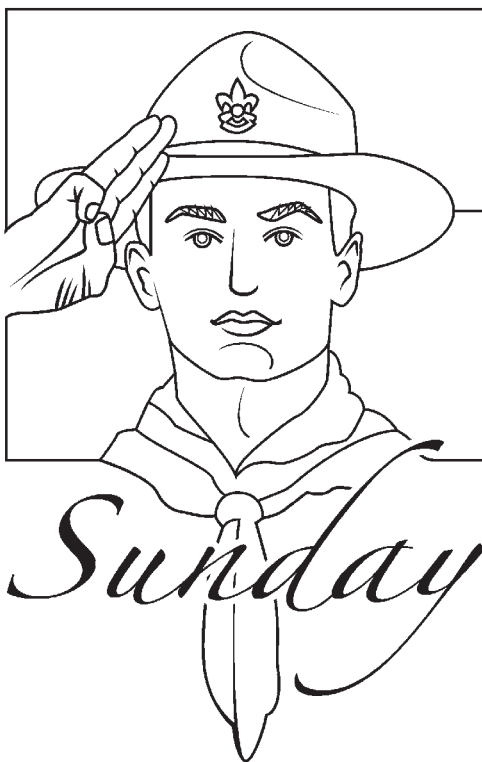
