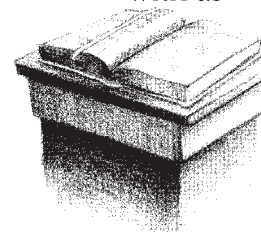

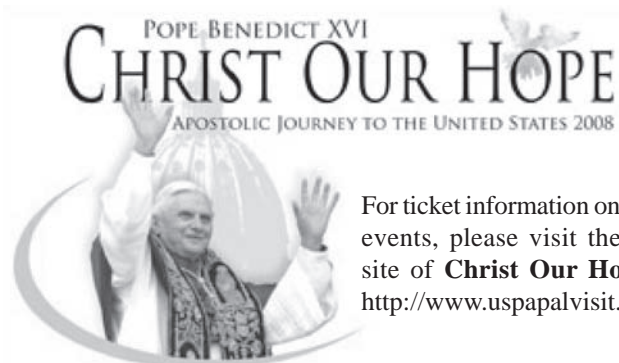


## Christ Our Hope
