Catholic Scripture Study International

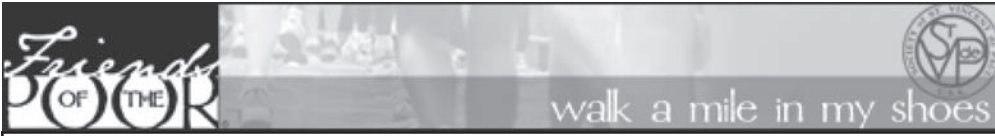

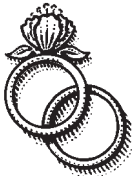
