**In Service to Others**

### Projects:

To Provide financial assistance to those individuals that are in need, Catholic and non-Catholic. Individuals and families are screened and their needs assessed. Referrals to the Community Service Committee are made by Catholic Charities and the Arlington Council of Urban Ministries, as well as through the parish office.

We collect school supplies for needy children in six elementary schools in our immediate area.

We have drives for socks and underwear for children in need in the same six schools.

We have an annual drive for presents and volunteers to host a party for the children from these schools, who would otherwise do without at Christmas.

We support Arlington Charities with the food that is collected on Pantry Sunday, in addition to helping them with their needs. We have also helped them in building platforms to store food and other repairs. Members of our committee help in transporting food from the food bank, weekly. We also participate in their "Feed Arlington Collection."

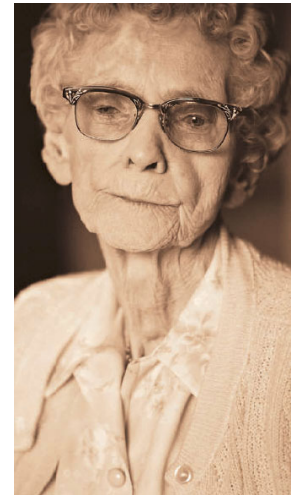
We extend support to I AM DANCERS, which gives needy children the opportunity to learn to dance.

We provide financial support to the Catholic Charities office in Arlington, which helps pay pharmacy bills for those who are unable.

We provide aid to the Crisis Pregnancy Center and Women's Shelter, and others, as the need arises.

We provide aid to the residents of the Nuestra Hogar Home. In the past, we provided Thanksgiving dinners for the over 60 residents; provided them with household items when needed; and devoted the "Angel Tree" to collecting items they needed as gifts for Christmas.

In order to assist as many needy families as possible, we work with other charitable organizations in Arlington to meet the financial needs of those who are struggling.
